These changes are to implement WUTC Order No. 05 in Docket No. UE-050482. This is the outcome of Avista's General Rate Case filing of March 30, 2005. In this order, the WUTC approved and adopted a multi-party settlement agreement, subject to certain conditions. Avista accepted those conditions and the new rates were effective on January 1, 2006. This results in an annual increase in revenue of approximately \$21,387,000. A typical residential customer, using 1000 kWh's of electricity per month, will see their monthly energy bill raise approximately \$5.07 per month.
