This is a reduction of approximately 0.6 cents per therm for residential customers. Beyond this date, the Schedule 191 energy rate will return to the level established prior to September 5th, 2003, an amount consistent with a surcharge of 0.50% for energy efficiency and 0.79% for low income rate assistance.
